

FLOATING ELEMENTS - HAMBURG ZOO HAGENBECK

One of the many attractions in the Hagenbeck – Zoo in Hamburg is the popular Birma – Temple, completely surrounded by a small lake. To cover the foundation a narrow belt of floating islands has been installed around the temple.



The floating islands have been placed in early 2004. The pictures are showing the development a couple of month later in June. A low metal fence has been attached to the floating elements to keep the many exotic waterfowl on the lake off from grazing the plant.



The new arrangement of the temple blends perfectly in the landscape of the park (May 2007)
